



A Quick Guide

In case this is the first paper hero that you have tried making, here are some simple instructions that may make assembling it easier.

First, cover every tab on every bit of paper with double sided sticky tape. If you prefer you can glue parts together as you go along, but I find sticky tape less messy.

When you cut out each part, make sure you look for any instructions. Then fold along all the dotted lines and fold all the tabs. You should begin to see how that part takes shape before you actually begin sticking it together.

Most importantly... enjoy yourself. Try not to get too frustrated if it isn't coming together straight away. Stick at it and the model will soon start to take shape.



When the face is attached, curve the top of the hair over the head and stick to the top of head.

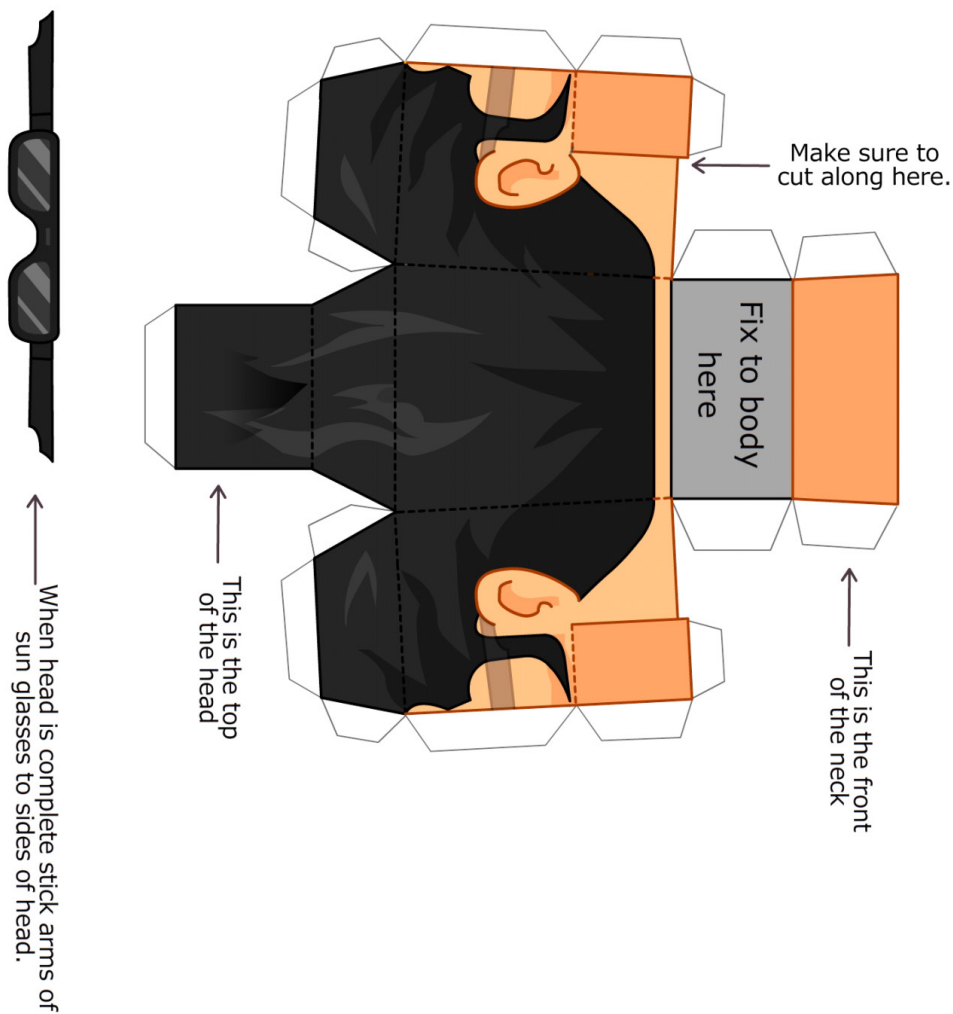
This folds back to form the base of the jaw

Face/Front of Head

Build the whole rest of the head from the next page before adding this part to the model

Back, top and sides of head.

Build this part first before adding the face/front of the head to the model



Begin work with the back of the body.
Add the left and right sides and then
add the inside of the legs. Once the
whole back and sides have been built
you can add the front to the body.

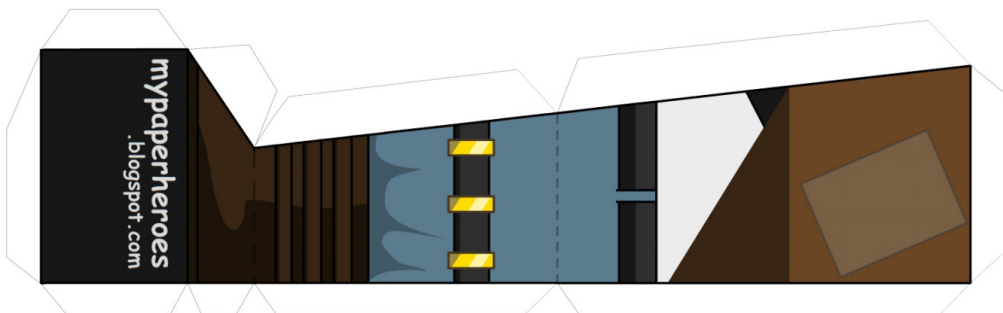
Front of Body



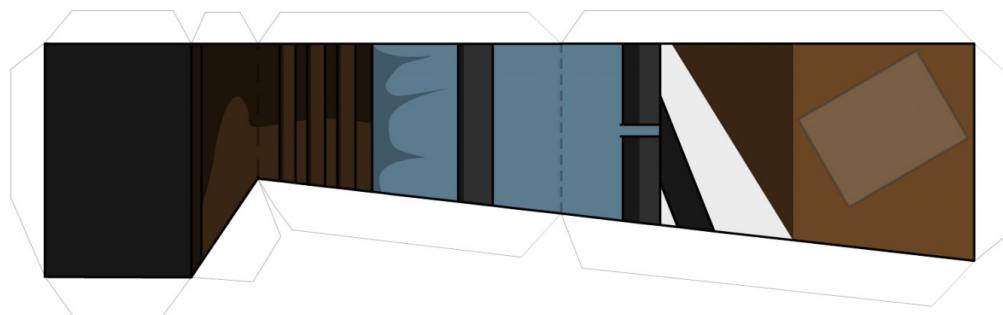
Back of Body



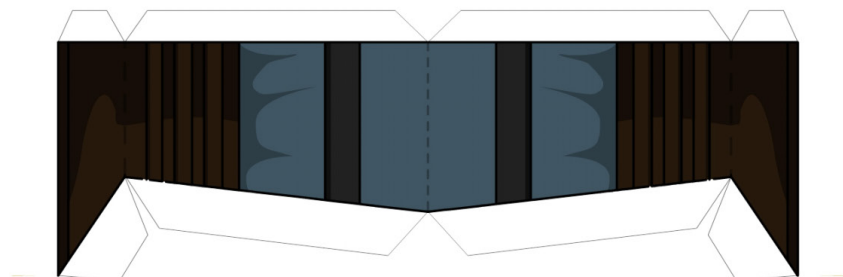
Left Side of Body



Right Side of Body



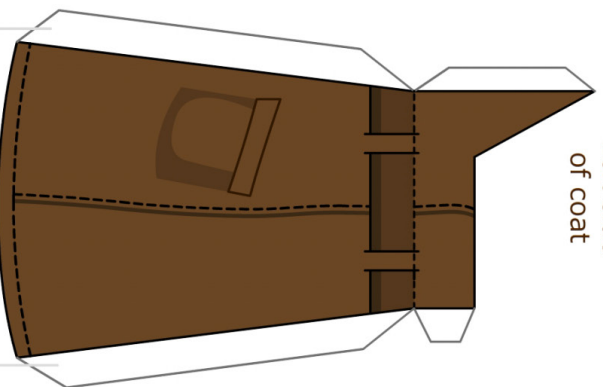
Inside of legs



Stick the left and right sides of the coat to the back of the coat. Then stick the front sides to the left and right sides. The easiest way to piece it together is to make sure that the belt runs straight through around the coat. When the coat is built the back of the coat sticks to the back of the body. The coat wraps around the body. The tabs on the top of the front sides of the coat stick to the front corners of the top of the body.

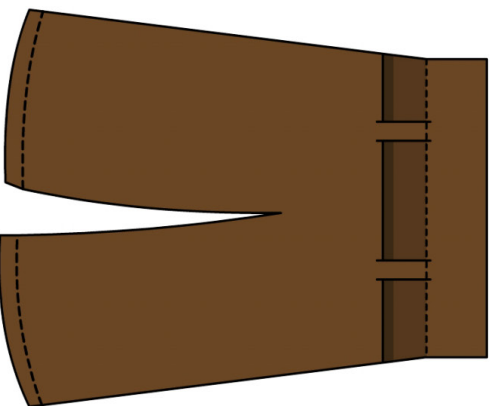
The back of the collar can then be stuck behind the head and the front of the collar on to the front of the coat.

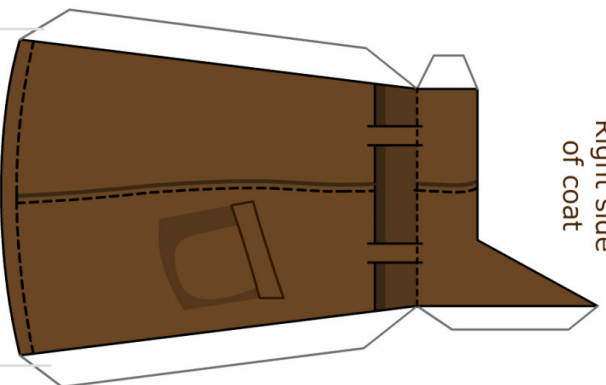

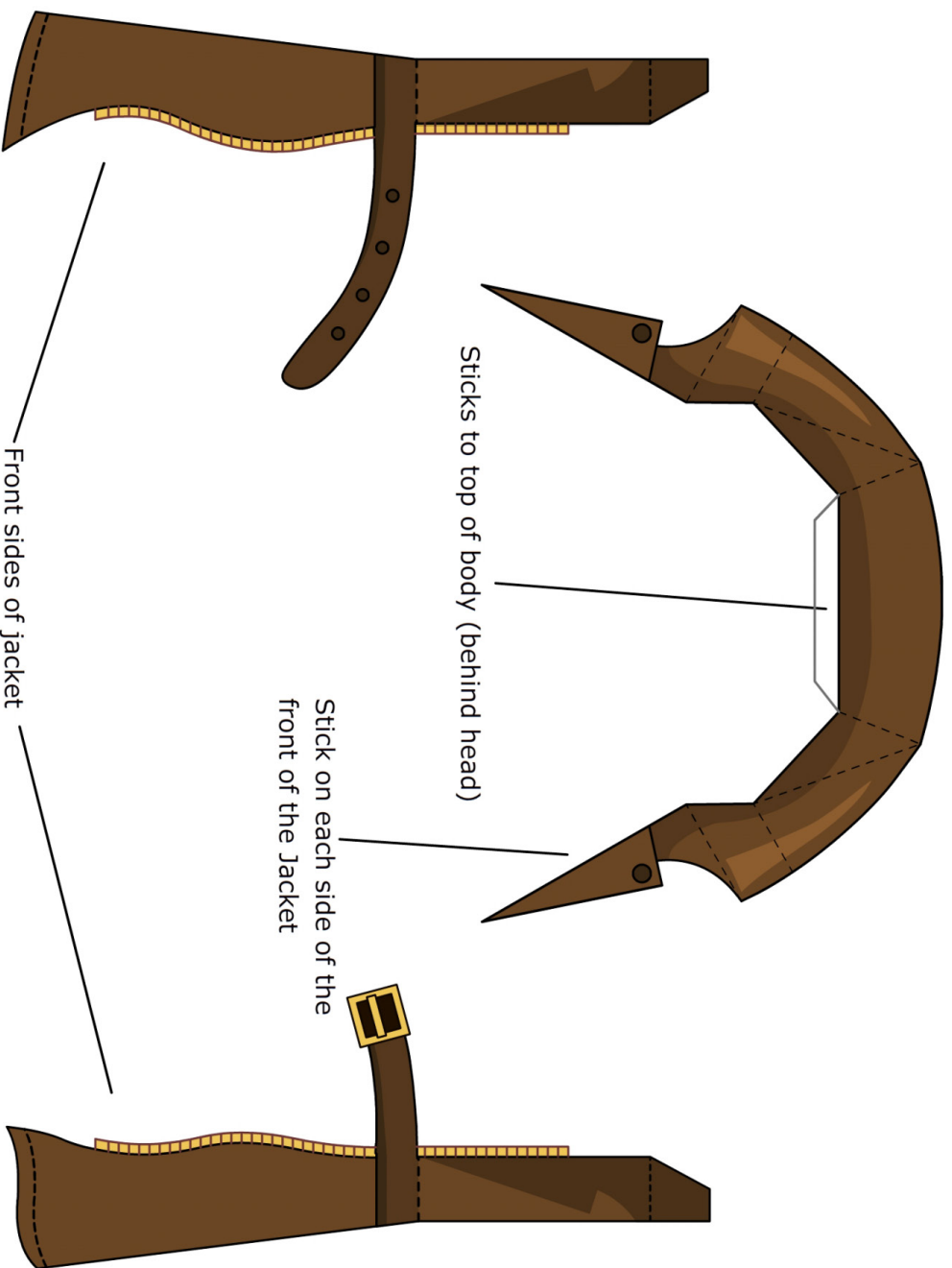
Back

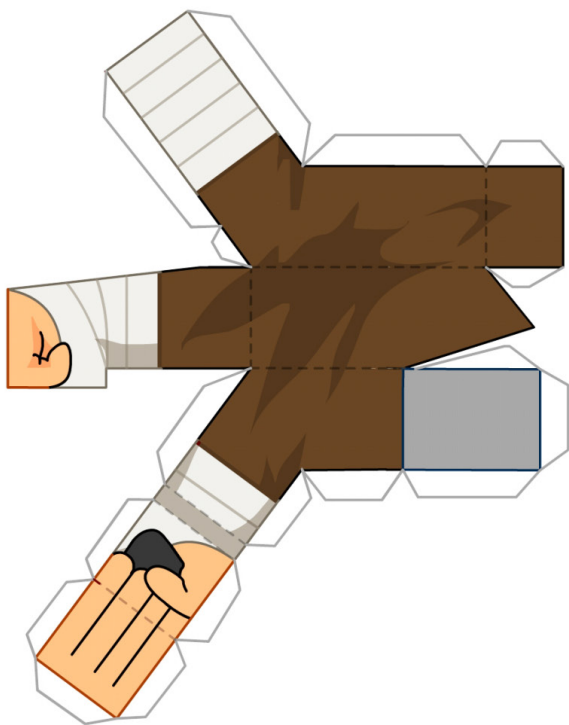

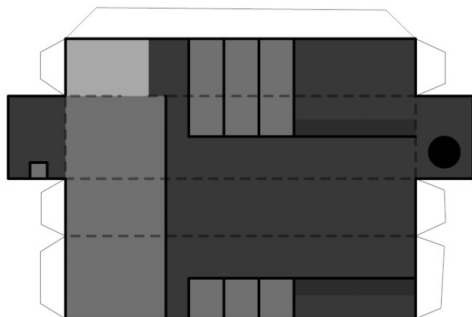
Build up the complete main part of the arm and then fix the front of the arm in place. Once this is complete you can wrap the cuff around the hand and add the gun



Front of Left arm



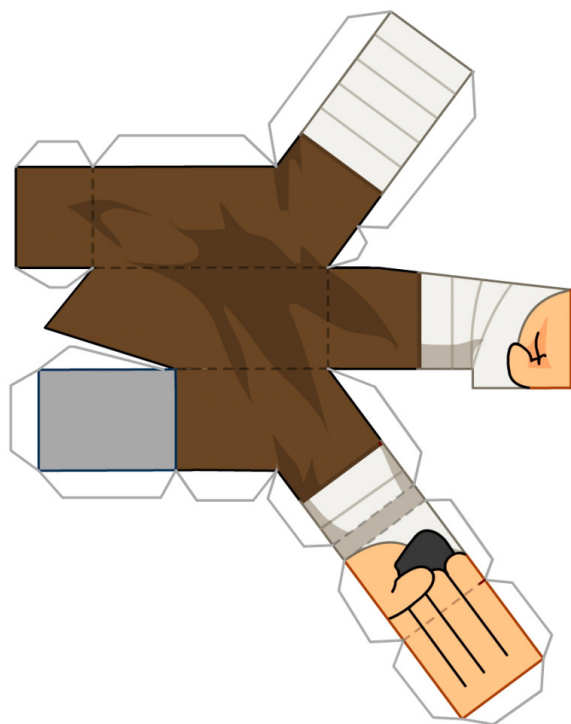
this folds into a cuboid

Right Arm



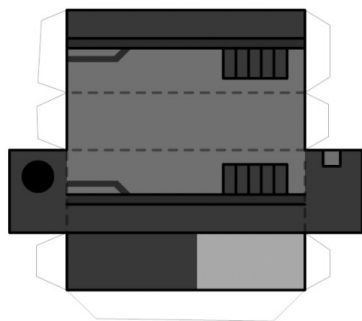
Front of Right arm
